- Round-trip bus service, departing the Grundy Rec Center (475 Beaver Street, Bristol Borough) at 8:30 AM sharp and returning at approximately 7:30 PM. Please park, ONLY, in the front row facing the school.
- Bus arrives at the Liberty State Park Terminal, Jersey City, NJ where ferries are boarded to Liberty and Ellis Islands
- Admission covers both islands including self-guided audio tours. Guests tour independently at their own pace.
- The 30 minute film “Island of Hope, Island of Tears” is showing at the Ellis Island National Museum of Immigration.
- Dinner at the historic Cranbury Inn, Cranbury, NJ. Dinner includes a Caesar salad, the choice of entree (choose below), roasted red potatoes, fresh green beans, apple pie, a beverage, and rolls with butter.
- The tour involves extended walking and may not be suitable for guests with limited mobility.
- Visitors can purchase or bring food for lunch or snacks on both islands.
- Fee covers all gratuities for bus driver, tour escort, and restaurant servers.
