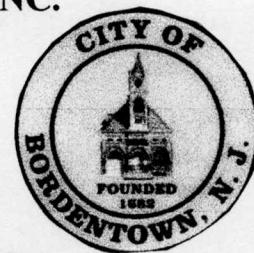

Itinerary includes:

- * Round-trip motorcoach transportation, departing the Grundy Rec. Center (475 Beaver St., Bristol Borough) at 10 a.m. sharp. Park in front row facing the school. Estimated return time is 4:45 p.m.
- * Introductory video, followed by a docent-led tour of the museum and a leisurely walking tour of the Historic Village, established in 1905 by Charles G. Roebbling as a complete self-sustaining community with brick houses for the workers. In the case of rain, the tour will be by bus with guide on board.
- * Three-course lunch at the Old Town Pub on Farnsworth Ave. in Bordentown. See below for entree choices.
- * **NEWLY ADDED!** Visit to Point Breeze, former estate of Joseph Bonaparte.
- * Gratuities for bus driver, trip escort, local guide and restaurant staff.

PLEASE NOTE: Bus seats are assigned on a first-paid basis. Your cancelled check will serve as your receipt. Refunds for cancellations will be granted only if replacements are obtained. Price of trip is based on a minimum of 45 paid passengers.
